FORMAT OF THE SPECIAL GENERAL MEETING

As per the High Court ruling

1. Karakia
2. Statement from the Chair explaining the circumstances and rules of the Special General Meeting.
3. Receiving and recording of apologies
4. Oral statements may be made by candidates
5. Booth voting for nominated candidates
6. When the Chair considers that all eligible voters have cast their votes, the Chair will declare booth voting closed
7. The Electoral officer will count all the votes and declare the successful candidates elected
8. The Chair will allow both successful and unsuccessful candidates to address the meeting.
9. No correct Notices of Motion were submitted and no new ones will be allowed to be introduced.

VOTING PROCEDURE

The Special General Meeting on Saturday 23 August 2008 will be at Te Reo Mihi Marae, Te Hapua, beginning at 9.00 am.

You can vote for the candidates you wish by either of two ways. You will have only the one vote, so you must choose between having a postal vote or by secret voting at the Special General Meeting.

If you want a postal vote, please complete the form below and post it to me. The Court has ruled that requests must close on **Sunday 27 July 2008** (28 days before the Special General Meeting) The voting papers will be posted out to you as soon as I receive your request, no later than **Saturday 02 August**. A stamped addressed envelope will be included in this post out for your convenience. They must be returned to me no later than **Saturday 16 August**, ie 2 weeks later. IF they arrive later than this the Judge has ruled that be invalid votes and will not be counted.
