

Location of the Land Blocks:

These Māori freehold land blocks can be located in Taumarunui, in the Aotea region and consist of 439.9712ha.

Long-Term Aspirations: The long-term aspiration is to increase the productivity of the existing sheep and beef farming operation and to ensure it's full potential.

Project Description: This project seeks to build the capabilities of the Trustees and provide information to make well-informed decisions on how to improve current farm performance.

Outcomes: Development of report and advice to inform decisions including a whole farm assessment and a farm business plan.
