Official Information Act request

Thank you for your information request dated 3 December 2018. You asked for the following information:

"A copy of Te Puni Kōkiri's independent observer report for the Te Hikutu cluster hui held from 30 November to 2 December 2018"

Your request was originally made to the Ministry of Justice on 3 December 2018. On 13 December 2018 the Ministry of Justice transferred your request to Te Puni Kōkiri for response as Te Puni Kōkiri is responsible for providing independent observers to observer and report on Treaty Settlement mandate hui. Your request has been considered in accordance with the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act).

One document has been identified in scope of your request. The document and my decisions with regard to the release of the information are set out in the table attached as Appendix A. I trust my response satisfies your request.

A letter was drafted by the facilitator and signed by kaumātua. This was tabled at the hui and read out aloud to attendees. The letter outlined the decision making and voting processes followed over the two day hui (not observed by TPK staff) and noted the results.

Key points of discussion

- Safe loving environment, surrounded by our tupuna where people can have their say without fear of criticism. Our hearts and minds have been filled with the wairua of our tupuna.
- Not feeling rushed into a decision. Easy flow encouraged people to ask questions and express themselves.
- Several speakers had come to the wananga a definite no but after listening to the korero and strengthening their bonds with other whanau they were comfortable looking to the taumata and the wider ahi ka to guide their decision making.
- Privileged to have been part of the process. He whanau kotahi tātou regardless of whether we voted yes or no.
- Noted that those that did not attend for the duration of the wananga brought another wairua into the whare – found this challenging
- Acknowledgement of the effort put into the three days by the ropu whakahaere and Te Hikutu dotcom team.
- Information provided in a way that helped whanau to understand the issues they were asked to make a decision on. Provided with all the information we needed to make an informed decision.
- Praise for the facilitators who guided the hui through a rangimārie process. Ahakoa ngā piki me ngā heke i te roanga ake o te wānanga, kua u rātou.
- Importance of having a photographer at the wānanga to provide a record of this important occasion available for whānau not here and our future generations.
- Several speakers spoke to the long and difficult journey to today and the personal toll on themselves

Several speakers expressed their disappointment that the deluge of negative messages circulating on Facebook were hindering people from making an informed decision about the proposal. Hopeful that the hapū outcome will lead to something good for their mokopuna Two speakers expressed their disappointment with the voting outcome. One was concerned that 6 hapū voting yes is a big chunk of Hokianga hapū worried that those hapū who voted no would now be left out. Anxious that the hurt caused by the mandating process has further divided the hapū of Te Hikutu, noting some of those who voted no were angry about the outcome and had not returned to complete the houhou te rongo process today. Important to bring younger generation into the conversation so that they fully understand the issues
Hui resolution(s)	No resolutions were put to the hui while Te Puni Kökiri staff were in attendance. However, a letter delivering the outcome of hui a hapū (displayed on screen and read aloud) outlined the following: The hui agreed that the process for decision making would be tikanga opoopo and include: Whānau attending (in person) and via Zoom (reaffirmed at the start of each session) Tātai hono would apply for the duration of the hui
	 A decision to confirm pepeha-a-hapū A decision to amend the programme to accommodate whanau needs A decision to exclude individual votes Agree to hapū making a decision collectively for questions 2,3 and 4
	There were no challenges to the decision making process outlined or the outcome of that while Te Puni Kōkiri were in attendance. One attendee questioned the inclusion of whānau attending via zoom in the voting process.
Decision- making process	Following the powhiri the facilitator provided an overview of the tikanga that the hapu followed to reach their decision on the evolved mandate proposal. The outcome of this process to be delivered via letter, signed

by the Kaumātua of Te Whakaminenga O Te Hikutu (provided to TPK staff on the day and attached).

The facilitator opened the floor for whānau in attendance on Sunday 2 December to share their whakaaro and reflections on the proceedings and outcome of the wānanga. All those present took the opportunity to share their kōrero with the whare. A summary of that kōrero is included in the key points of discussion section of this report

Summary comments

- The Observer and scrutineer's role at the hui was explained accurately.
- The hui was conducted in an open and transparent manner.
- Hui attendees had the opportunity to ask questions and questions were answered.
- We did not observe the decision making process being agreed or the voting processes that occurred prior our attendance.
- The reflection of the participants indicated that there was an agreed decision making process and outcome from the vote.

Based on the documentation received and reflections observed:

- The registration process and whakapapa verification was adhered to.
- Decision-making process for each hapu was clearly explained by the facilitator
- A clear decision was made on voting process to be used
- Agreed voting process was adhered to for questions 1, 2 and 4. For question 3, agreement was by way of verbal agreement.
- Whānau expressed being able to ask questions and learn about the history of the mandate before making a decision.
- Whānau also expressed feeling like they were given an opportunity to safely express their views regardless of their individual position.

- At the hui people had the opportunity to talk to (and reflect on) the process that had occurred
- The process that was undertaken was not disputed or challenged during the hui.

At our Hui-ā-Hapū 30th November 2018 to 2nd December 2018, the following outcomes were completed by Te Hikutu, Ngati Kairewa, Ngati Tuapango, Ngati Kerewheti, Te Whanau Whero, Ngati Parenga and Whanautara.

OUTCOMES:

- Our tikanga and decision for notification of our Hui-ā-Hapū was authorised and approved on the 4th November 2018 at Moria Marae, Whirinaki.
