Purpose

- 1. This paper outlines two tranches of investment proposals for the Māori Covid Communities Fund (MCCF) to support Māori Vaccination Acceleration and seeks your approval to proceed to contracting to eight proposals, with total contract value of \$23.451m.
- 2. This briefing includes revised proposals from Tranche 1 (submitted on Wednesday 29 October) and Tranche 2.
- 3. Agencies intend to proceed with contracting immediately following your approval.

Proposals for approval

- 4. Eight proposals (outlined below) have been identified in Tranche 1 and Tranche 2, with a total investment of \$23.351m. Agencies have also prepared short summaries (Attachment 1) to support each proposal, using information provided by applicants to ensure clarity and consistency of information to inform decision making.
- 5. Ministry of Health, Ministry of Social Development, Te Arawhiti and Te Puni Kōkiri have all reviewed the proposals, provided feedback and endo
