#### **Purpose**

- 1. This paper outlines Tranche 3 investment proposals for the Māori Covid Communities Fund (MCCF) to support Māori Vaccination Acceleration and seeks your approval to proceed to contracting to two proposals, with total contract value of \$1.450m.
- 2. Agencies intend to proceed with contracting immediately following your approval.

# **Proposals for approval**

- 3. Two proposals (outlined below) have been identified in Tranche 3 with a total investment of \$1.450m. Agencies have also prepared short summaries (Annex 1) to support each proposal, using information provided by applicants to ensure clarity and consistency of information to inform decision making.
- 4. Ministry of Health, Ministry of Social Development, Te Arawhiti and Te Puni Kōkiri, the agency with responhave all reviewed the proposals, provided feedback, and endorsed.
