




Results across mandated government agencies for the period 1 July – 31 December 2021 (almost 97% of agencies submitted their reporting)

Almost two thirds of contracts with Māori businesses were in four regions: Wellington, Auckland, Northland and Waikato.

Number of active contracts by region




Māori businesses were awarded 5.7% of contracts between 1 July and 31 December 2021




The initial target for the policy is 5% of total contracts across government are awarded to Māori businesses.

Māori businesses operate in a wide range of sectors, however healthcare is the most common.

The average value of these Healthcare services contracts is \$830,000. Building and Facility Construction and Maintenance Services have the highest average contract value of \$11.8 million.



Contracts with Māori businesses are not evenly distributed across agencies. Almost 90% of contracts with Māori businesses were held by just a quarter of agencies (35 agencies).



The number of contracts awarded to Māori businesses increased from the first to the second half of the reporting period.
