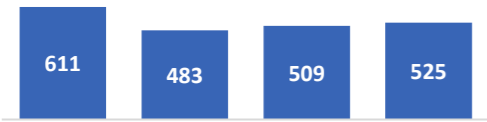
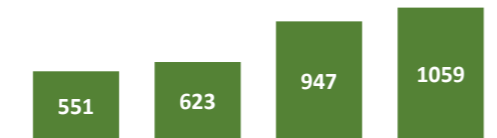

Successful Wave Seven agreements total \$1.7m including Te Punanga Haumaruru and smaller fund requests

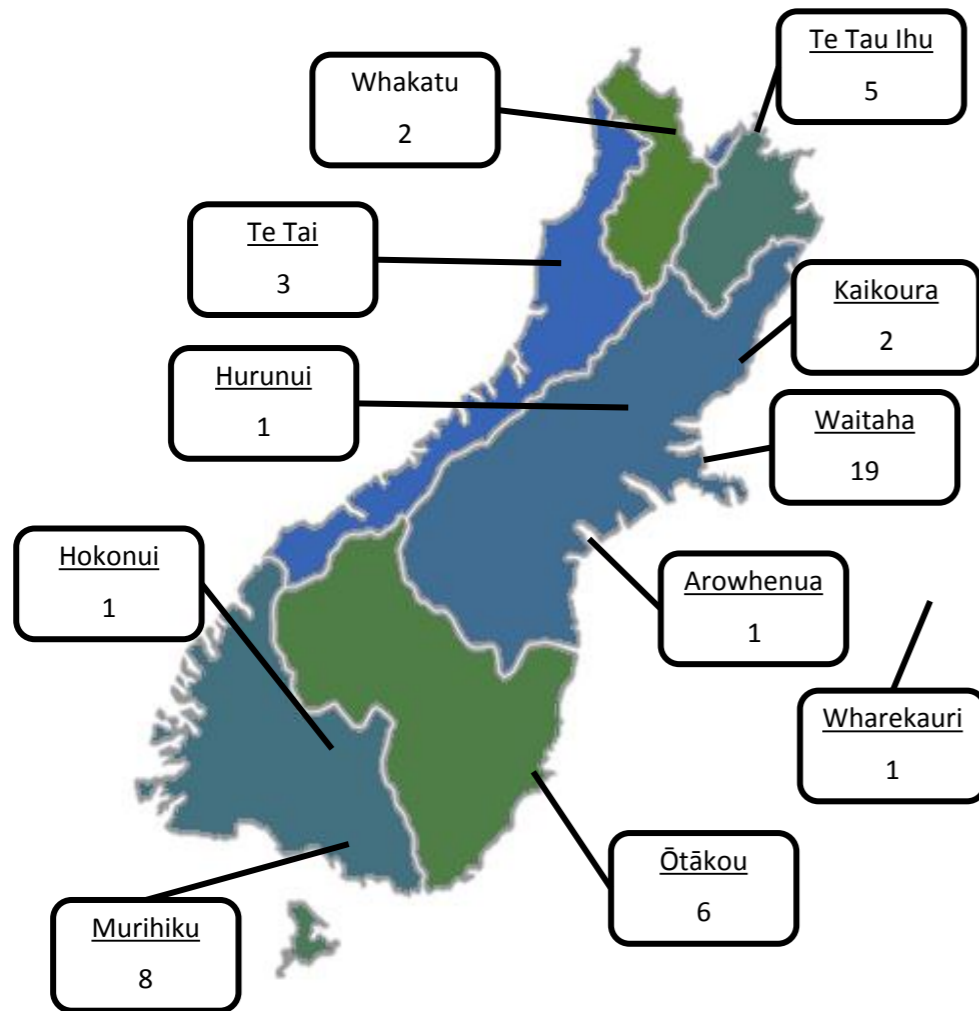


Planning is currently underway for the Whānau Ora Symposium being held in Blenheim between 21st to the 23rd March

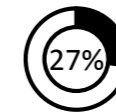

## NOTES TO RESULTS

- Total engagement in quarter 2 has increased by 9% from quarter 1
- The average whānau engaged per navigator per quarter has increased to 21.6
- There are currently 6 navigators assisting with recovery relief and whānau planning

## CASE STUDY (WHĀNAU STORY)

Kahurangi is a 30 year old Ngāti Porou dad that suddenly become a solo parent of a nineteen months old Maia after his wife took her own life. At the time, Kahurangi had no home and no income to support his young daughter. They were sleeping on the couch at his aunt's two bedroom house occupied by three other adults. A Whānau Ora Navigator was engaged to assist Kahurangi to receive sole parent benefit support and ensure Maia is enrolled with an ECE provider. The next priority is to make an application for social housing.
