K2 block - exploring development opportunities

Kauangaroa No. 2 Māori Reservation (K2 block)



Location of the Land Blocks: Located in the Whanganui region, this Reservation is 64 hectares of Māori Freehold Land.

Long-Term Aspirations: To explore different uses of land and investigate new ways to boost land productivity that aligns with the aspirations of their hapu.

Project Description: This project seeks to utilise expert advice to investigate three main focus areas that have been identified so far for Ngā Wariki Ki Uta and the K2 block on the feasibility of the following specific development projects: honey business, forestry (or other carbon credit farming opportunities) and horticulture.

Outcomes: Feasibility report that will support the Trustees/ owners decision to optimise the use of their whenua.

Partners: Kauangaroa No 2 Māori Reservation, Ngā Wairiki ki Uta, Tuia Group Limited and Te Puni Kōkiri
