Location of the Land Blocks:

1200 ha of Māori freehold land in Ikaroa-Rāwhitiregion.

Long-Term Aspirations: The long-term aspiration is to operate across the value chain of the Mānuka honey resource – from land to brand, adding value all along the way from plant to the consumer.

Project Description: This project seeks support to development a Land Use Management and Information tool that will identify existing Mānuka stands, hive management and honey flow. The tool (an e-whenua platform) will support the land trusts to make decisions on best utilisation of their existing Mānuka stands.

Outcome: Increased productivity, capability and understanding by participating individual land owners and trusts of their mānuka honey resource. Qualitative information that will enable the trusts to make better decisions on best utilisation of their existing mānuka stands and future growth.
