Official Information Act request

Thank you for your information request dated 17 November 2021. You asked for the following information:

"This is an Official Information Act request for any information from the Ministry of Health, Te Arawhiti and Te Puni Kōkiri regarding funding distributed for Māori health needs, in particular in relation to Covid-19.

"We are looking for information on this funding, how it has been allocated and distributed, and to who."

On 19 November 2021 your colleague Odette Brierley clarified the request:

"We are seeking any information on any funding distributed for Māori health needs in relation to Covid-19. This is not exclusive to the Māori Communities Covid-19 Fund (MCCF).

"We are seeking any information from the last 18 months."

Your request has been considered in accordance with the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act).

Te Puni Kōkiri has recently published a response to another enquiry under the Act, which asked for information on the Māori Communities COVID-19 Fund. Regarding other funding, Te Puni Kōkiri reports and lists our investments made within each financial year as part of our suite of annual report documents. Please see the attached spreadsheet Appendix A for details of our 2020/21 and 2021/22 funding recipients; the

2019/20 information is publicly available. We have provided a summary of each of these years' activities below.

2019/20:

In March 2020, we established the Whānau Māori Community & Marae Response Fund to provide immediate support to whānau, communities, marae and businesses affected by the COVID-19 pandemic.

Throughout these documents we have reported on the impacts COVID-19 has had on our investment funds in 2019/20, and we have listed all investments made in the 2019/20 financial year. You can also find information on other COVID-19 investments made in 2019/20 in these documents.

2020/21:

We are in the process of preparing the 2020/21 Te Pōti Whanaketanga Māori: Vote Māori Development and 2020/21 Investment Recipient List reports, which are expected to be published in early 2022. As these are yet to be published, please see Appendix A for a Table of all COVID-19 related initiatives invested in 2020/21 that relate to *“funding distributed for Māori health needs in relation to COVID-19”*.

In 2020/21 we established the Building Sustainable and Resilient Communities Fund. This supports Iwi and Māori organisations to build community resilience by investing in capability and community infrastructure, so that our communities are better protected against future economic shocks. While there are elements of economic resilience, some of the resilience-building includes health initiatives. As it is difficult to differentiate between a “health” project and a “non-health project” we have included all investments made in the Building Sustainable and Resilient Communities Fund.

Other investment funds which are included are:

- Rangatiratanga Grants
- Māori Development Fund, General
- Te Pū Harakeke
- Rangatahi Suicide Prevention Fund.

While these funds were not established specifically to support COVID-19 initiatives, they have the scope to support COVID-19 specific projects that relate to Māori health and wellbeing.

2021/22:

COVID-19 specific funds open during 2021/22 (to 18 November 2021) include:

- Building Sustainable and Resilient Communities Fund
- COVID-19 Whānau Recovery Fund
- Regional Vaccination programme
- Māori Communities COVID-19 Fund (Phase 1).

Other investment funds which are included are:

- Rangatiratanga Grants
- Māori Development Fund, General
- Te Pū Harakeke.
