## Proposed Overseas Travel: Hon Willie Jackson

Portfolios Broadcasting and Media / Māori Development

On 21 November 2022, Cabinet:

- 1 **authorised** the absence of Hon Willie Jackson from New Zealand, subject to leave from Parliament being secured, from 11 to 17 December 2022 to travel to:
  - 1.1 Paris, France to speak at an event for the International Decade of Indigenous Languages;
  - 1.2 Dublin, Ireland to meet with the General Director of Raidió Teilifís Éireann, Ireland's public media broadcaster;
- 2 **agreed** that he be accompanied by one member of staff;
- **3 approved** the estimated expenditure of up to \$67,844.00 for the travel expenses of the ministerial party as a charge to Vote: Internal Affairs (Members of the Executive Travel);
- 4 **noted** that he will also be accompanied by officials from Te Puni Kōkiri and the Ministry for Culture and Heritage, whose travel costs will be met by their agencies;
- 5 **agreed** that in his absence:
  - 5.1 Hon Carmel Sepuloni act as Minister of Broadcasting and Media;
  - 5.2 Hon Peeni Henare act as Minister for Māori Development;
  - noted that leave from Parliament has been sought.
