### Official Information Act request

Thank you for your information request dated 2 October 2023. You asked for information regarding Corcoran Road, RD 5, Te Pahu, specifically:

- *if Dad had to right his kids us in any of those papers bak in 1987, would be awesome"*

Your request has been considered in accordance with the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act).

A thorough search of our records has been conducted and Te Puni Kōkiri does not hold information in relation to Corcoran Road, RD 5, Te Pahu. Therefore, your request for information is refused under section 18(e) of the Act as the information requested does not exist or, despite reasonable efforts to locate it, cannot be found.
