Thank you for your information request dated 28 September 2023, which has been considered in accordance with the Official Information Act (1982). Your questions and our responses are as follows:

1. "How many renewals of warrants are pending - as at 1 September 2023

(by region)?"

There were 27 re-appointment applications pending as of 1 September 2023. Please refer to the below table for a list of pending Māori Warden reappointments, broken down by region as at 1 September 2023
