### Official Information Act request

Thank you for your information request dated 6 November 2023. You asked for the following information:

*"I would like to request a copy of your organisations chart covering the top four tiers (tier one to four). If at all possible, I would like the names of the managers as well as their titles. If this is not possible (in regard to their names), I would like to know why".*

Your request has been considered in accordance with the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act).

We have interpreted your request to be for a copy of Te Puni Kōkiri's organisation chart, which includes the names of managers and their titles, for tiers one to four.

Te Puni Kōkiri does not currently have an organisation chart. Therefore, we have refused your request under section 18(e) of the Act as the information requested does not exist.
