


# Whenua Māori overview 2024

The total number of whenua land blocks nationally is more than 28,000. These blocks collectively cover an area of about 1,400,000 hectares. Nearly 60% of these blocks lack a management structure. Each of these has an average area of 15 hectares. Approximately 40% of Maori land blocks have a management structure. These land blocks average 98 hectares in size.


## Whenua Māori in Te Tai Tokerau

The total number of whenua landblocks in Te Tai Tokerau is about 5,100, collectively covering an area of approximately 133,000 hectares.




### Whenua Māori in Tāmaki Makaurau


The total number of whenua landblocks in Tāmaki Makaurau is about **600**, collectively covering an area of approximately 14,000 hectares.




### Whenua Māori in **Te Waipounamu**

The total number of whenua landblocks in Te Waipounamu is about 1,800, collectively covering an area of approximately 55,000 hectares.
