Proposed Overseas Travel: Hon Tama Potaka - August 2025

Portfolios Conservation / Māori Development

The Hon Tama Potaka recommends that Cabinet:

- authorise his absence from New Zealand, from 3 to 11 August 2025 to travel to Hawai'i, United States and British Columbia, Canada to undertake bilateral meetings;
- 2 agree that he be accompanied by one member of staff;
- approve the estimated expenditure of up to \$40,181 for the travel expenses of the Ministerial party as a charge to Vote Internal Affairs (Members of the Executive Travel);
- 4 note that he will be accompanied by a senior official from Te Puni Kōkiri, whose travel costs will be met by their agency;
- note that he will also be accompanied by his wife, whose costs will be met by him personally;
- 6 agree that in his absence:
 - 6.1 Hon Chris Penk act as Minister of Conservation;
 - 6.2 Hon Judith Collins KC act as Minister for Māori Crown Relations: Te Arawhiti;
 - 6.3 Hon Shane Jones act as Minister for Māori Development;
 - 6.4 Hon Louise Upston act as Minister for Whānau Ora;
- 7 note that the House is not sitting during his absence.
