As part of this change, the four iwi prototype contracts with **Ka Uruora Trustee Limited**, **Toitū Tairāwhiti**, **Ngāti Kahungunu lwi Incorporated**, and **Te Pouahi o Te Taitokerau** have been transferred to MHUD, who will continue to lead and support this important kaupapa.
