Official Information Act request

Thank you for your information request dated 23 Huitanguru 2025. You asked for the following information:

“Could you please send me information on funding for Papakainaga in 2023/24.

This information should include size (number of houses) and location of papakainga, funding for the different stages (eg Concept / feasibility / Infrastructure / build) as well as any specific information on costs for consultants for these projects.”

On 28 Huitanguru 2025, we emailed you to advise that Te Puni Kōkiri has published our Investment Recipients List for the 2023/24 financial year on our website at: [Te Puni Kōkiri Investment Recipients List 2023/24](#).

We indicated that it would be helpful for you to refer to this information in the first instance, and if you require further information, to advise which specific projects you are interested in, and exactly what information relating to those projects you are seeking.

We noted that Te Puni Kōkiri is unlikely to hold information on consultancy costs and this information is likely to be held by the kaitono.

On 10 Poutūterangi 2025, we sent a further email to confirm whether the information provided in our response of 28 Huitanguru 2025 satisfied your request.

As at today’s date, we have not received a response from you. We are now in a position to respond.

Your request has been considered in accordance with the Official Information Act 1982 (**Act**).

Information relating to Māori Housing Network funding can be found in the above link (pages 10-19 refer). The information is broken down by region and provides the kaitono,

initiative, total approved funding, and 2023/24 funding. The information specifies the different stages of papakāinga projects broadly.

I trust my response satisfies your request.
