"...can you confirm that prior to the tender process for Whānau Ora agencies, TPK altered the allocation of budget and shifted \$12 million from the funding going to Pacific providers over to Māori providers.

And if so, can you please explain why this was done, what funding now goes to which agencies, and what Pacific services were impacted?

Also, is this the funding distribution going forward"?
