### **Official Information Act request**

Thank you for your information request dated 12 August 2025. You asked for the following information:

1. *“We act for the Wai 2003 (Ngā Hapū o Te Wahapu o Hokianga Nui a Kupe) and Wai 3269 (Ms Geneva Hakaraia-Tino on behalf of herself and tangata whaikaha Māori) claimants, representing their claims in the Waitangi Tribunal.*
2. *This letter is sent with regards to information related to the Pae Ora (Health Futures) Act 2022 (‘the Act’) held by the following government departments and Crown entities:*
  - a. *Te Kawa Mataaho Public Service Commission;*
  - b. *Manatū Hauora Ministry of Health;*
  - c. *Te Whatu Ora Health New Zealand;*
  - d. *Ministry of Social Development;*
  - e. *Department of Prime Minister and Cabinet; and/or*
  - f. *Te Puni Kōkiri Ministry of Māori Development.*
3. *Therefore, this letter concerns, but is not limited to, the following Ministers:*
  - a. *Minister of Health;*
  - b. *Public Service Minister;*
  - c. *Minister of Māori Development;*
  - d. *Minister for Social Development and Employment; and*
  - e. *Minister for Māori Development.*
4. *Pursuant to the Official Information Act 1982, we respectfully request a copy of the following information:*
  - a. *In relation to review of the Pae Ora Act, any or all communication and/or advice to and/or from the government departments and Crown entities outlined in paragraph 2(a)-(f) related to;*
    - i. *review of the Act from the period beginning 24 January 2025 to date; and*

- ii. *the above, particularly consideration of section 6 (Te Tiriti o Waitangi/the Treaty of Waitangi) of the Act.*
- b. *In relation to the Health Assurance Unit, any or all communication and/or advice to and/or from the government departments and Crown entities outlined in paragraph 2(a)-(f) related to;*
  - iii. *the establishment of the Health Assurance Unit ('the Unit') within the Public Service Commission; and*
  - iv. *details of the purpose of the Unit and the Unit's initial work, which was referenced in an OIA request response dated 17 March 2025 (reference: PSCR 2020-0202).*
- c. *In relation to Iwi-Māori Partnership Boards ('IMPBs'), any or all communication and/or advice to and/or from the government departments and Crown entities outlined in paragraph 2(a)-(f) related to;*
  - i. *the role and status of Iwi-Māori Partnership Boards from the period beginning 24 January 2025 to date; and*
  - ii. *direct correspondence with any of the 15 IMPBs that are currently in place across the country from the period beginning 24 January 2025 to date.*
- d. *Other;*
  - i. *any or all communication and/or advice to and/or from the government departments and Crown entities outlined in paragraph 2(a)-(f) related to the status of Te Pae Tata Interim New Zealand Health Plan 2022, in particular priority action two, and Pae Tū: Hauora Māori Strategy."*

The Official Information Act 1982 (**Act**) requires that we advise you of our decision on your request no later than 20 working days after the day we received your request. On 11 July 2025 we notified you that unfortunately it was not possible to meet that time limit because we needed to consult with other agencies. We advised you that we were needing to extend the time to make our decision until Friday 8 August 2025.

On 8 August 2025 we confirmed that we decided to grant your request. We also advised you that it would take us additional time to prepare the information for release and that we would send you the information by Friday 15 August 2025, or as soon as reasonably practical.

We are now in a position to respond.

Your request has been considered in accordance with the Act.

Three documents have been identified in scope of your request. The documents and my decisions with regard to the release of the information are set out in the table attached as Appendix A.

Some information has been withheld in accordance with the Act on the following grounds:

- Section 9(2)(a) - to protect the privacy of natural persons
- Section 9(2)(f)(iv) - to maintain the current constitutional conventions protecting the confidentiality of advice tendered by Ministers and officials
- section 9(2)(g)(i) - which maintains the effective conduct of public affairs through the free and frank expression of opinions
- section 9(2)(h) - which applies to maintaining legal professional privilege.

In making the decision to withhold information, I have considered the public interest considerations in section 9(1) of the Act.

After a comprehensive search of our records and of emails, using key search words and names of kaimahi likely to have received communications in relation to the subject areas identified in your request, we were only able to identify communications in relation to section 4 (a) of your information request. We hold no information in relation to sections 4 (b) and 4 (c) of your request. Any information in respect of section 4 (d) is withheld in full as this matter is still under active consideration.

I trust my response satisfies your request.

1. **Note** that the paper does not provide any justification for the proposals relating to Māori interests (Cab paper paras 17-20) beyond the objective to clarify, streamline and simplify the statutory settings, roles and responsibilities for the health system. No rationale or analysis for how the proposals will help to achieve this objective is provided.
