### Proposed Overseas Travel: Hon Nanaia Mahuta

**Portfolio**                      **Māori Development**

On 11 March 2019, Cabinet:

- 1        **authorised** the absence of Hon Nanaia Mahuta from New Zealand, from 12 to 16 March 2019, to travel to Chile to be a keynote speaker at a workshop on indigenous women's development and for other meetings relating to her portfolios;
- 2        **agreed** that she accompanied by one member of staff;
- 3        **approved** the estimated expenditure of up to \$42,800 for the travel expenses of the Ministerial party as a charge to Vote: Internal Affairs (Members of the Executive – Travel);
- 4        **agreed** that in her absence:
  - 4.1      Hon Willie Jackson act as Minister for Māori Development;
  - 4.2      Hon Kris Faafoi act as Minister of Local Government;
- 5        **noted** that House leave has been approved.
