Purpose

 This paper provides you with a progress update from the Independent Technical Advisory Group (ITAG), on the process to review the Treaty of Waitangi Act 1975 (the Review).

Background

- 2. The Review, and the appointment of ITAG was announced on 9 May 2025. The scope of the Review is provided in the Independent Technical Advisory Group Terms of Reference.¹
- 3. On 28 July 2025, ITAG provided its monthly written briefing to update the Ministerial Advisory Group (MAG). ITAG met with you to discuss this briefing on 29 July 2025.

Progress update

- 4. ITAG is now in phase four of the Review, and we remain on track with all deliverables and timeframes as outlined in **Table 1** below.
- 5. We have confirmed with your office that the draft report will be provided to MAG on Thursday 21 August 2025.
- 6. ITAG have considered the feedback you shared in your meeting with us on 29 July 2025, as part of ITAG's ongoing deliberations.
- 7. ITAG have met for a series of focused workshops to finalise our recommendations. We are now engaged in the writing of a technically focused report.

High-level engagement summary

- 8. A high-level outline of themes from engagement insights was provided in the MAG briefing on 28 July 2025.
- ITAG has organised and participated in 43 engagement events as part of the Review process. This includes meeting with Iwi Chairs and CEOs at the National Iwi Chair Forum on 3 July 2025, and 42 events organised by ITAG:
 - 39 hui / meetings with individuals and groups
 - 3 wānanga.
- 10. In the 42 events organised by ITAG, we met with 153 individuals, either in person or online.
- 11. In addition to the hui and meetings held by ITAG, we received 44 written submissions. The majority of written submissions were received from claimants or claimant representatives, iwi/hāpu and Māori organisations.

Risks and mitigations

- 12. The Review carries inherent public, political and operational risk. Risks and mitigations are actively monitored, reviewed and updated regularly as needed.
- 13. ITAG and the Secretariat consider that current mitigations are effectively minimising and/or addressing risk appropriately.

Next steps

- 14. ITAG will provide a full draft report to you as MAG Chair, for you to forward to your MAG colleagues, by 10.00am Thursday 21 August 2025.
- 15. ITAG will be providing you with a final report of Review recommendations by the end of August and early September 2025.
