report;


- 3. noted the recommendations of the Evaluation Panel;

The Steering Committee considered the overall number of respondents per region participating in the RFP stage of the procurement. Following discussion, the Steering Group made further resolutions.

 deficiencies in the quality or scope of ROI responses in the event that some respondents did not have
 adequate time to prepare for the ROI submission;
